

Jilka Apartment - Prague Information Sheet

Old Town Square – turn right out of the front door and walk for about 3 minutes to the end of Jilka street. You will see the Square on your right. If you leave by the back door, turn left and then left again and it is about 2 minutes ahead of you.

Tesco (nearest supermarket) – turn left out of the front door and walk up to the main road. The supermarket is in the basement (separate entrance to the right of the front door). You can buy drinks etc on the ground floor. Open 7 days a week. Ground floor closes at 10pm on weekdays, 8pm at weekends. Main store closes 9pm weekdays.

Wenceslas Square – walk left from facing Tesco for about 3 minutes and you will be at the bottom of Wenceslas Square.

National Theatre – you will find the National Theatre by facing Tesco and turning right along the main road for about 3 minutes. It is just before you get to the river. A number of well known operas are shown there, and tickets can be bought in the box office which is next to the theatre.

Café Louvre – this is the best place close by for breakfasts (from 8am). It is on the second floor of the building on the right of Tesco (as you look at it). The words Café Louvre are in big letters on the building.

Cashpoint machines (ATMs) – the nearest ones are on this side of the main road facing Tesco – one on the left and one on the right, and there are several others in the centre.

Laundry – if you are staying for a longer period Halina (the receptionist) will do your laundry for you for a small charge and deliver it the next day.

U Vejvodu – this is a very good Czech/German style beer hall located about 20 metres from the main entrance of the flat (left out of the front door). From the street you will see a bar area and the main restaurant is downstairs.

Le Terroir – a new wine cellar which can be accessed from the front courtyard of the building. It is rather expensive but the wine is very high quality and it offers a chance to see the 12th century original features in the basement.

Security – please **DOUBLE LOCK** the door of the flat when you are out.

Heating in the flat – the main boiler is located in the hallway and there should be no reason to touch it. There is 24hr hot water. The temperature in the flat is controlled by the thermostat on the wall just inside the main room. We suggest you turn it down to 10° or below during the night, otherwise the boiler may fire up. If a red light appears on the boiler please contact the receptionist.
